- The children are also confident in their ability to use the smartboards.

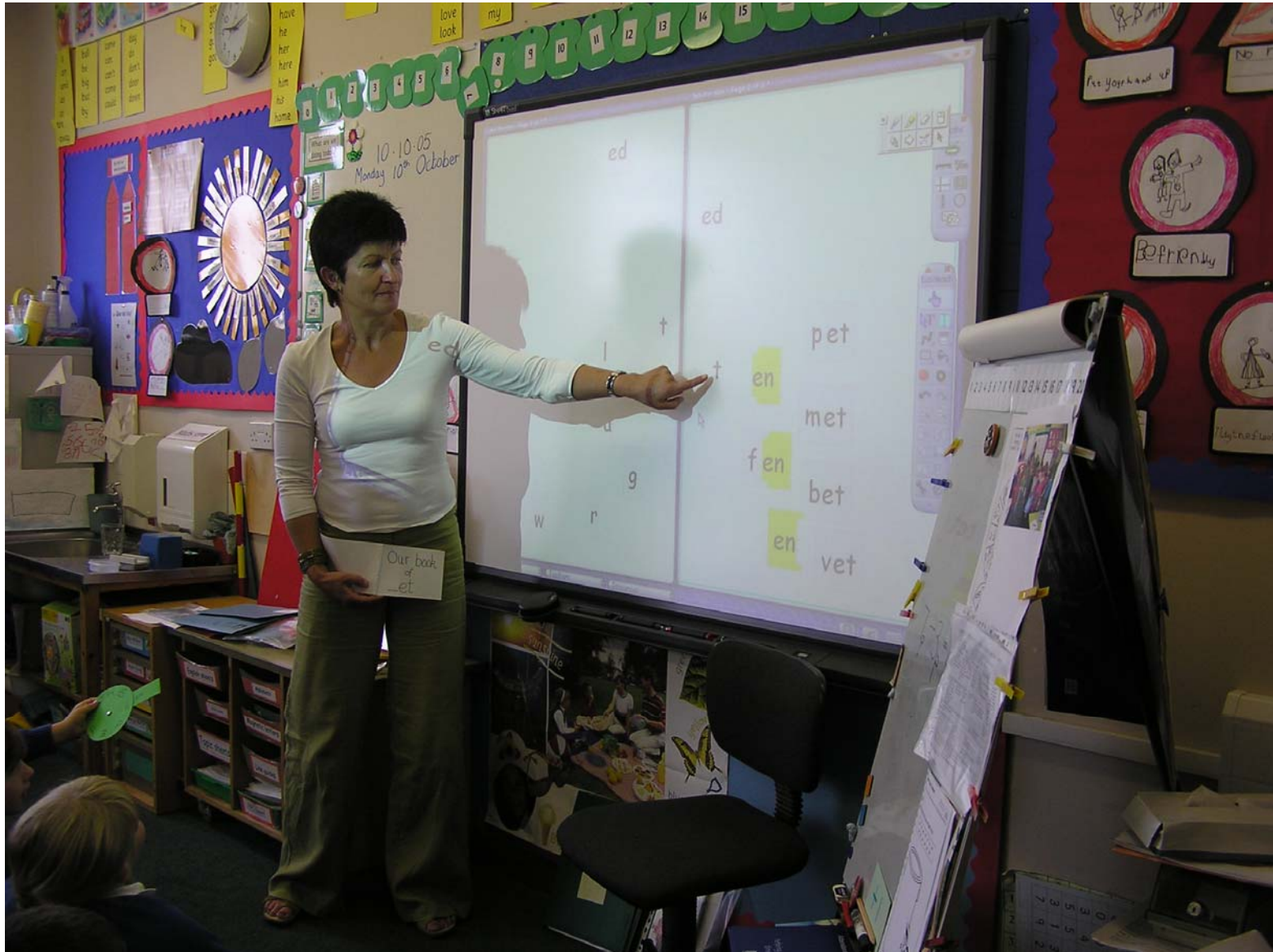
We use our interactive whiteboards in all our teaching.

Teachers are keen to use the smartboard for cross-curricula purposes.



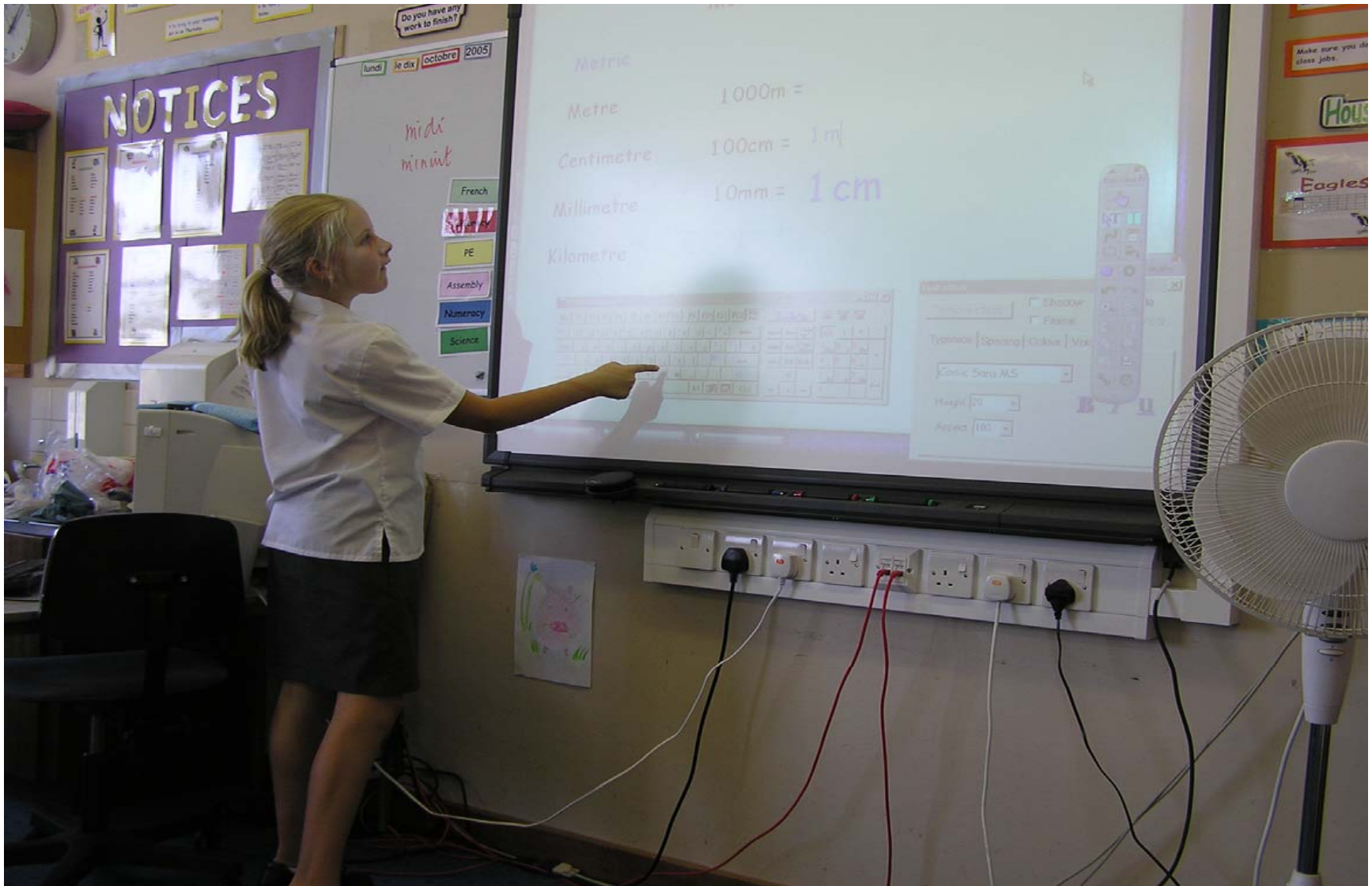
Year 1 children are learning about the sounds of words.
