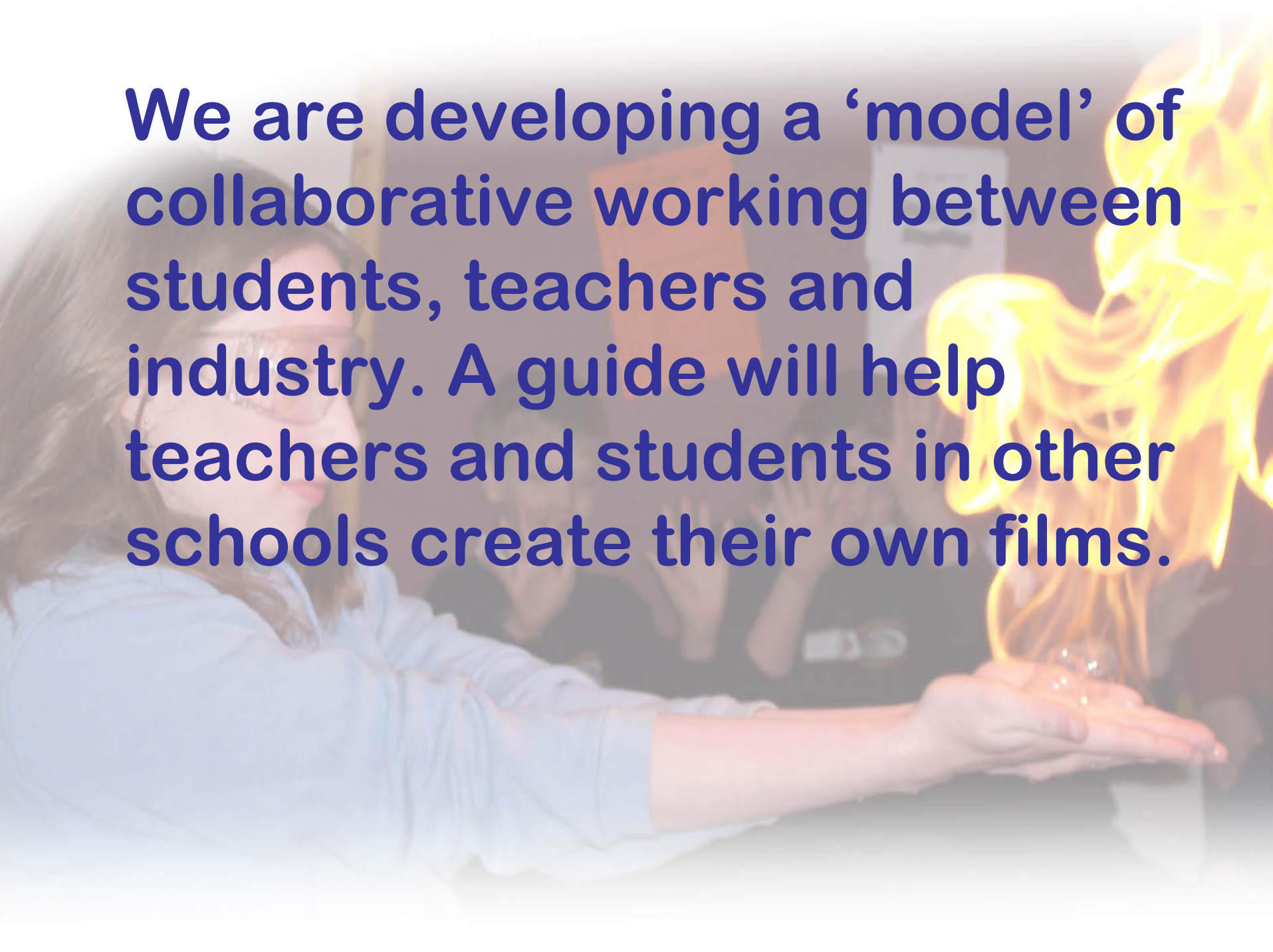
We believe that students know what engages other students . We wish to empower students and enable them to have a creative input in their learning.



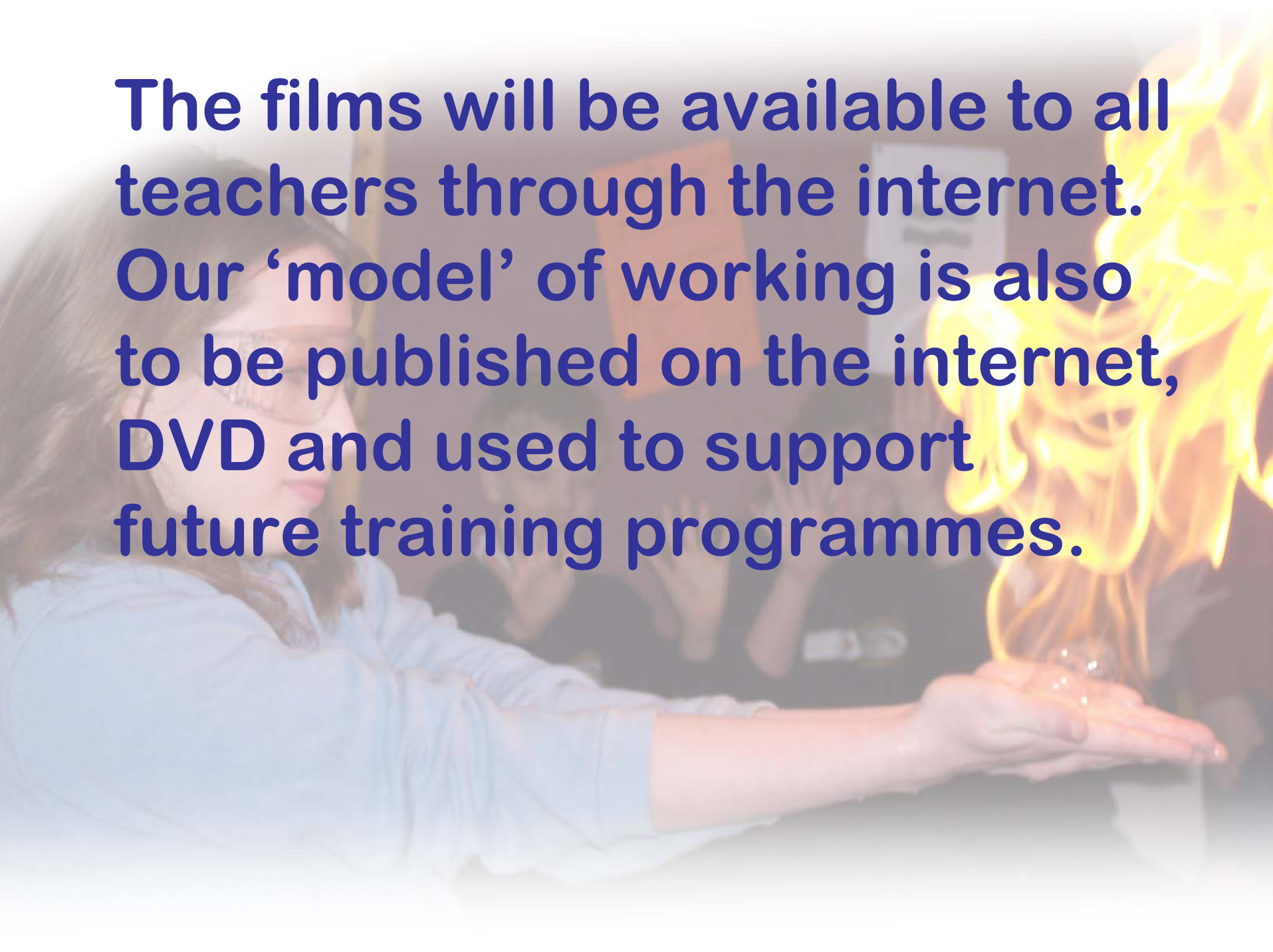
We are working with 'Toolkit' a digital media production company. Toolkit are helping us produce films for teachers and students in Science and Design Technology.



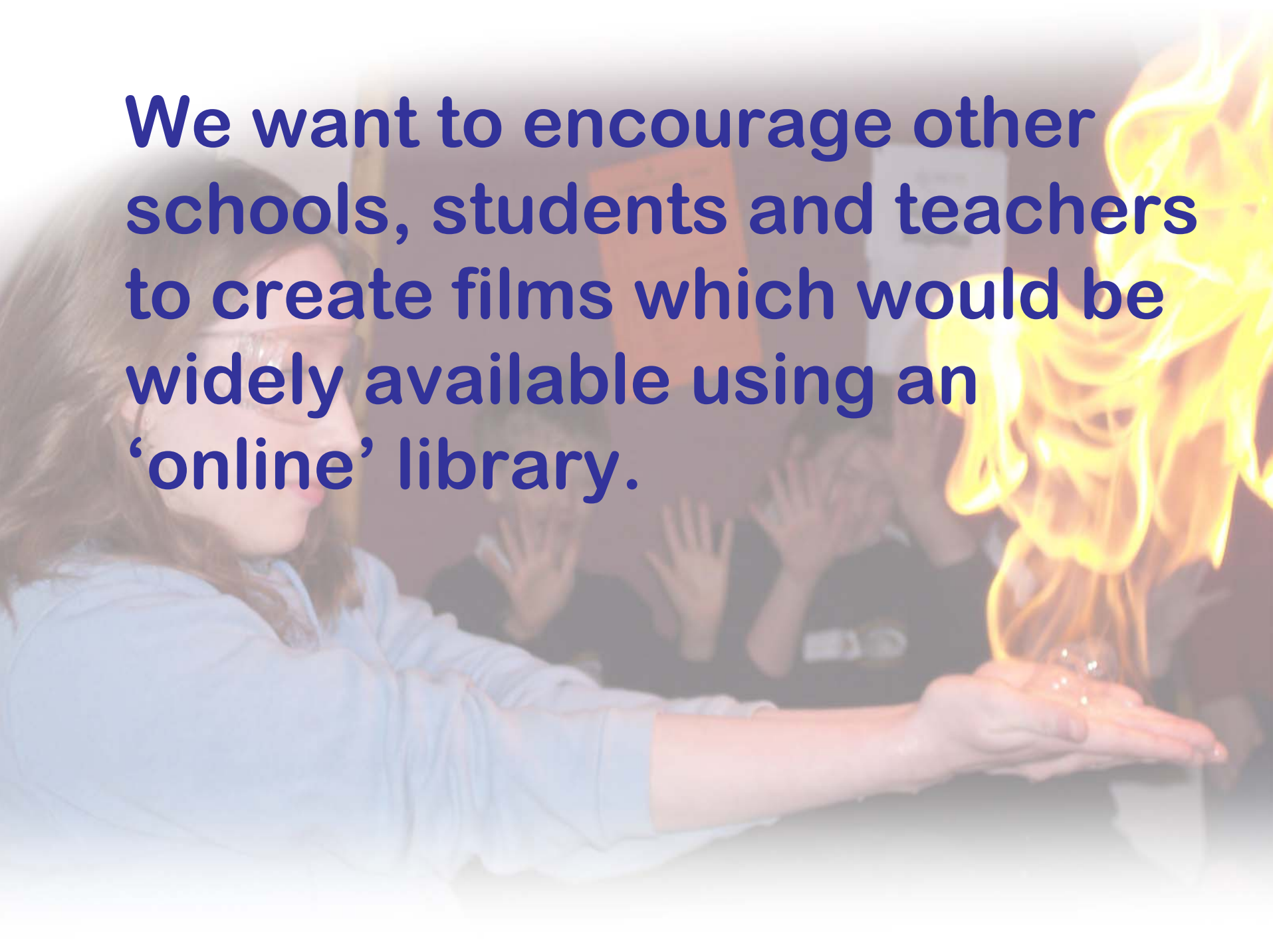
We are developing a 'model' of collaborative working between students, teachers and industry. A guide will help teachers and students in other schools create their own films.
